Geography Curriculum Launch Day

On Tuesday, Year 1-6 each had a Geography based workshop, focusing on how they can have an impact on looking after our environment, delivered in school by Green Up your Act. Year 1 and 2 learnt all about where our food comes from in the world, dispelling the myth that it just comes from the supermarket, and learnt about food miles and how by reducing food miles and growing our own food, it is better for the planet. The children then got



to plant their own micro-greens which, if looked after, will grow into salad leaves to eat! Year 3 and 4 learnt about the harmful effect plastic is having on our environment and how if it is not disposed of correctly, it ends up in our seas, posing a threat to animals that live there and depend on the oceans for food. The children decorated cork fish with colourful, recycled scales to draw attention to this issue. Year 5 & 6 learnt about how reducing, reusing and recycling is better for the planet and how they can make a difference themselves at home. They made their own notebooks out of old maps and scrap paper, seeing how something useful can be created out of items we might normally throw away. Lots of fun was had by all through this experiential learning.
