Warm up

Discussion

Activity 1

Look at the image of the mother and the baby below.

Write down some things that a baby can't do and needs an adult to do for them. The role of a parent in caring for a baby, which is why a parent needs to devote a lot of care to looking after them.

How does/might it feel to have a new baby in the family? Discuss with an adult.

Activity 2

Draw three pictures in sequence to show changes that happen for one of the babies in the warm up activity: from birth, to being a child/young animal, to being fully grown. Ask them to write a short description about the changes that occur as the baby grows into an adult
