<p>Afternoon learning</p>	<p>Geography WALT: I can explain the changes of a coastal Environment.</p> <p>Use All about coastal erosion (3dgeography.co.uk) as a discussion point on how erosion works.</p> <p>Look at different coast images Coast images (3dgeography.co.uk) ask the children what features they can see, what might have happened to these coasts and how may they have looked in the past. Remind them that coasts are constantly changing over time.</p> <p>Watch videos of the cliffs collapsing, get children to think of why this could be. Coast videos (3dgeography.co.uk)</p>	<p>Jigsaw WALT: Identify what job I want, what motivates me and what I need to do to achieve it. Appreciate opportunities of education and understand how it builds my future.</p> <p>"My ideal job is... because..." ask children to discuss this in pairs and then get feedback.</p> <p>Read "when I grow up" PK Hallinan.
