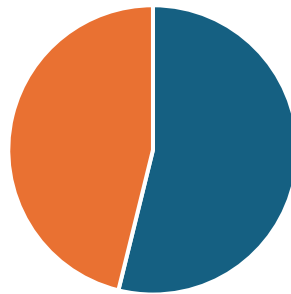


Parent Voice Questionnaire 2025/26

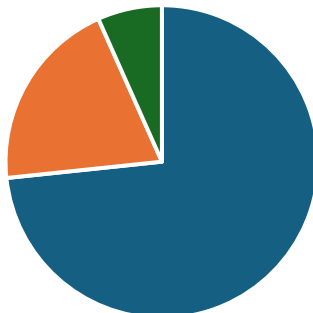
All parents with children on our SEND register were asked to complete our SEND Pupil voice. We provided a paper copy of the survey which was given to all parents of children with SEND. At the time of sending, we had a total of 42 children on our SEND Register which equates to 19% of the children in the school. We received a total of 13 responses. This is the second survey we have done as a school. We will continue to send a survey out annually now to ensure that our SEND provision is the best it can be across school. Please see our overview at the end of the survey feedback for what we will be working on to improve our provision for SEND across school, based on our responses.

I am aware of the support in place for my child.



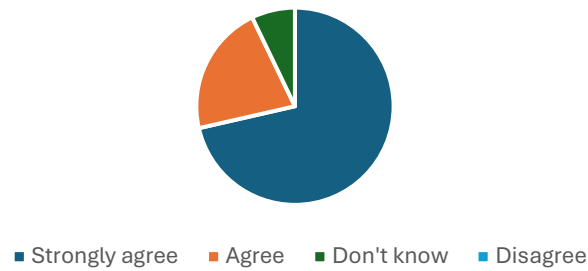
■ Strongly Agree ■ Agree ■ Not sure ■ Disagree

The SENcos are both approachable and friendly



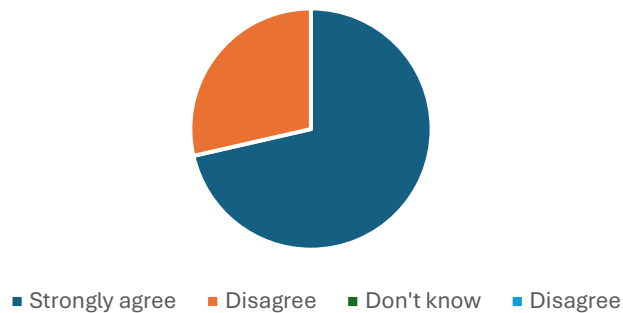
■ Strongly agree ■ Agree ■ Don't know ■ 4th Qtr

I know who to talk to if I have concerns about my child.

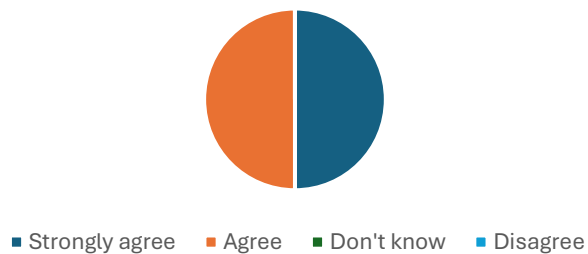

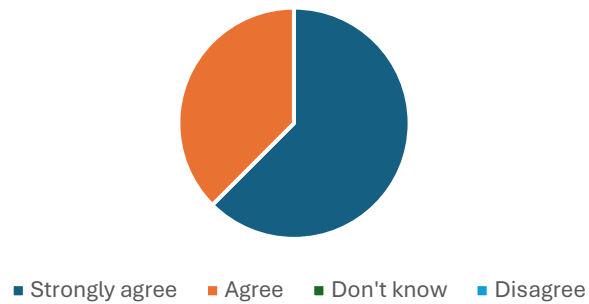
Issues I raise about my child are quickly addressed.



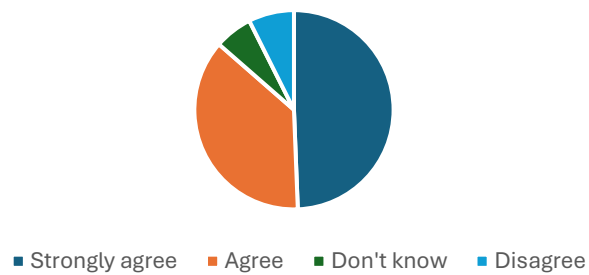
I am informed when outside agencies are in to see my child and receive copies of reports.



The school gives me opportunities to discuss my child's needs and progress.

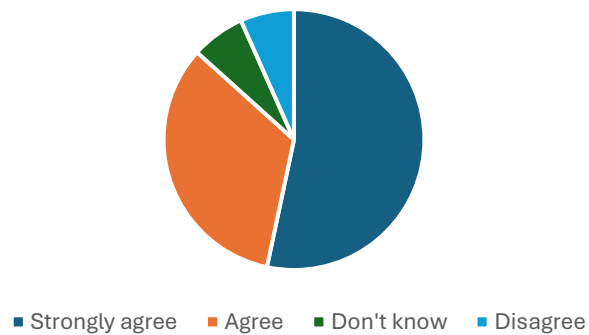


I receive feedback on how my child is doing in school.



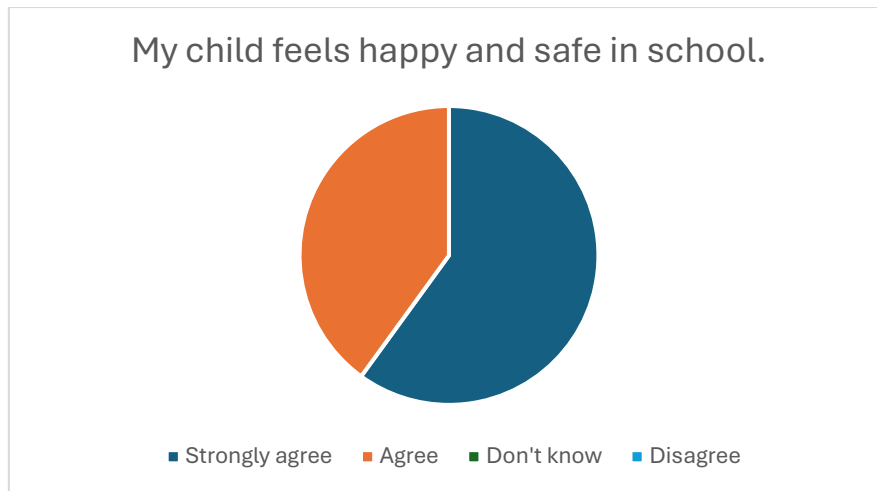
Additional comments: 'I would like my child's progression to be shared and understanding of class work to be explained well, so that I can help and support my child well'.
