In Pre-school activities are of a cross-curricular nature. This half term's activities will include..... Lots of activities to help your child to become more independent. Role play areas- Birthday Celebrations and Doctor's Surgery, activities that use our senses including walks around the school environment to discover what we can see, hear, smell and touch. A variety of cooking and tasting activities linked to our harvest celebrations.



We will continue our letter of the week using Jolly Phonics actions and songs - please check the notice board to see what the letter is. Copies of The Jolly Phonics song for that letter are available on the notice board or can be found online. Encourage your child to bring in any objects starting with the letter for our sound box. The children also experience lots of counting activities, counting up to 10 and beyond with a variety of number recognition activities that they can access independently.

At home.....Please talk to your children about their senses and how they can look after themselves. We really value your contributions to your child's Learning Journal, please feel free to add photos, pictures and any comments about what your child has been doing at home. Learning Journals can be taken home whenever you wish.
