



## **PE Grant Expenditure: Barford St Peter's C of E Primary School Report to Governors: 2017/18**

The government provided additional funding of £150 million per annum for academic years 2013 to 2014 and 2014-2015 to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools.

This Sport Premium Grant (SPG) funding is continuing in 2017/18 but its long-term future is unknown. This funding - provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport – has been allocated to primary school head teachers.

This funding is ring-fenced and therefore can only be spent on provision of PE and sport in schools.

### **Purpose of funding**

Schools must spend the additional funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but schools have been given the freedom to choose how they do this. A list of possible uses has been suggested. The school was allocated £13,633 funding for the year 2017-2018.
