



PE Grant Expenditure: Barford St Peter's C of E Primary School Report to Governors: 2019/20

The government provided additional funding of £150 million per annum for academic years 2013 to 2014 and 2014-2015 to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools.

This Sport Premium Grant (SPG) funding is continuing in 2019/20 but its long-term future is unknown. This funding - provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport – has been allocated to primary school head teachers.

This funding is ring-fenced and therefore can only be spent on provision of PE and sport in schools.

Purpose of funding

Schools must spend the additional funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but schools have been given the freedom to choose how they do this. A list of possible uses has been suggested. The school was allocated £17,320 funding for the year 2019-2020.
