

The Oxford Reading Tree



At Barford we use the Oxford Reading Scheme. It is a structured reading scheme for children aged from three. The intention is not just to teach children how to read but to help them gain an understanding of the structure of books and how to look after them.

There are two categories of books; those containing words and those which are purely illustrations. Phonological awareness is introduced through the scheme.

To be most effective both practitioners and parents are encouraged to take a role in teaching each child to read and to develop a love of books from the Early Years.
