

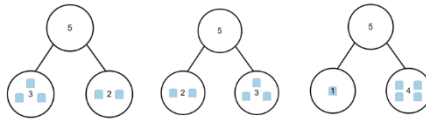
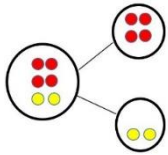
Reception Weekly Information

Theme: **Let's Build!**

Maths: Combining 2 groups

Combining two groups and recording using a part part whole diagram.



Literacy: Puddles and the Happy Easter Day

Revisiting digraphs oa, ie, er, ee and or.

Writing labels to describe the signs of spring.

Other activities:

Looking for signs of spring.

Read an account of the Easter events from a children's Bible and talk about the Bible as a special book for Christians to help them know more about God and Jesus.

Think of some of the things that people do at Easter to remember Jesus (go to church, send cards, have Easter eggs).

We have had another busy week and the children have continued to settle back into our class routines and have done some great work. We set no formal homework in Reception but it would really help your child's reading if you spend a few minutes each day sharing their reading book. If your child is really tired and reluctant to read you could play some word spotting games such as looking for the tricky words on each page. You could also look at their phonics grid so they become really familiar with all the single sounds and digraphs.
