



I am so impressed with how the children in Year 3 have returned to school! Now that we are back in the flow of class teaching in school, the following is a list of information to help with our Year 3 routines:

Book Change

Each child should have two reading books: one which stays at school; the other which remains at home. If your child is on the school reading scheme, they will change their books every **Monday** so please ensure their home reading book is in school on this day. If your child is a free-reader, they can change their books whenever they have finished reading them as we expect them to be on the same books for at least a couple of weeks.

Communication

Please continue to use the Year 3 email address to communicate with us about your child. I will check it daily for urgent issues such as changes to child collection from school. Absences, appointments or other issues should be communicated to the school office.

Spellings

The children will be tested on their spellings on a **Wednesday**. The spellings for the half term are available on Google Classroom in the Spellings section.

Times Tables

For the next couple of weeks, we will be suspending our times table tests. Children can still access work on Times Table Rock Stars, Hit the Button and Mathletics at their own leisure.

Forest School

Year 3 have their session every **Wednesday** afternoon. Please send your child in to school in full length appropriate trousers, waterproof coat and wellies (the latter of which can be left in school).

PE

We have PE on **Thursdays and Fridays**. Until the weather warms up, please send your child in PE kit with joggers rather than shorts. If your child wears stud earrings, please can they not be worn on these days.
