Our Learning

This half term our topic is 'We are Explorers' and we will be focusing on growing and the world around us.

In Literacy we will be extending our writing and challenging ourselves to write independently. The children have been working incredibly hard in phonics and we are using our knowledge to write full sentences. This term we will be reading a variety of books including Jack and the Jelly Bean Stalk, How to look after a dinosaur, Non-Fiction books about dinosaurs and Uno's Garden.

In maths we will be learning how to represent numbers up to 10 on a tens frame as well as our fingers. We will be revisiting doubles using different representations. We will also be comparing numbers and 'seeing' small quantities and numbers within larger quantities. Children will also be introduced to a rekenrek and will be using them to show representations of numbers. We will also be comparing quantities of objects.
