Our Learning

Literacy

We have been focusing our learning on sentence structure and developing our understanding of word classes. We are starting to become more confident at identifying nouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs and prepositions. We are going to start to use this knowledge to develop our writing in particular character and setting descriptions. Each half term we identify and audience and purpose for our writing. This half term we are going to create reference books for our classes containing all of our descriptions which we can refer back to when we start writing stories.

Maths

So far this half term we have been developing our knowledge of place value and looking at different mental strategies. Now we will be moving on to applying this knowledge to column addition and subtraction. We will start by focussing on the layout for the method as once the children have this secure it helps with larger numbers. We have started to practise our times tables using the timings that the year 4's will have for the check next year. The children are starting to remember not to panic when they see a question but to concentrate on answering the ones that they know.

R.E.

We have been looking at different religious symbols and what they represent. Holly class had a special project to create some wooden crosses for the school. They looked at what the cross represents in Christianity and chose a Bible story to depict on the crosses. With some cross curricular skills being used they measure, sawed, sanded and painted their crosses. They are now ready to be delivered around school.





Topic

This half term we are looking at WW1 the children have really enjoyed the topic so far and understand where it stands in history. When we looked at the trenches we couldn't believe what the conditions were like for the soldiers who had to fight and live in them. Next half term we will be looking at Ancient Greece and will be having a Greek Day where we will experience different parts of the Ancient Greek culture, have the opportunity to dress up and much more.
