Trip:

We had a fantastic time at Whipsnade Zoo we had the opportunity to see lots of different


animals and learn all about the differences between herbivores and carnivores in our workshop. For some of us we had our first opportunity to stroke some animals.











Literacy:

We have started a new fiction unit of work based on the book "The Story of Black Rock". This is a story about at girl who goes out on her boat but falls in, in the water she makes friends with Black Rock. We have been learning how we can vary our sentence length and use repetition for effect. Once we finish this unit we will be writing our own stories that continues the adventure.

Maths:

Year 3 have been exploring different types of lines; what they look like, what they are called and where we see them. We are now using hat knowledge to help us to describe the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

Year 4 have started looking at decimals. They have learned the place value columns for tenths and hundredths and used that to help them to write fractions as decimals and to compare them.

Spirituality:

This week during class assembly we focused on World Ocean's Day. We looked at the impact human actions have on oceans and discussed what we could do to change our impact. We then created some artwork to turn into posters to highlight the importance of preserving our oceans.

Sports Week:

We really enjoyed trying out lots of different sports we also had a visit from Perry the Commonwealth Games mascot. We had a football workshop, skipping, karate and circuits through the week and then we had the come and try festival on the Friday morning.
