Maths

Year 3 have been looking at the pattern when counting in 4s and 8s. We created arrays to help us to see the pattern and how it links to multiplication.

Year 3 have been looking at seasonal foods in D.T. We have identified where some of our food comes from and then used that to help us to design our own fruit kebabs.

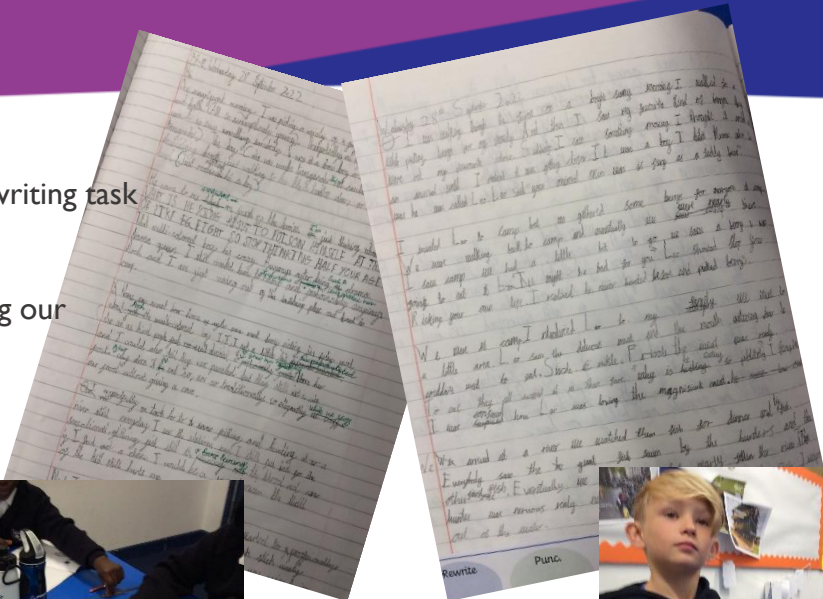


Our learning
