
There has been no Maths, SPaG or spelling homework set this week or next week (half term)

<u>Children's Mental Health Week:</u> We have had lots of fun completing a range of activities associated with Children's mental health week. During this week we have taken part in some activities linked to the theme of 'Let's connect' The children have enjoyed getting to know each other better by playing a special game of 'Bingo.' We worked together in teams to create a new game in PE and taught it to each other. We have also all designed a jigsaw puzzle piece which represents our individuality - we have then connected them together to make a beautiful display. Walnut and Sycamore class based their collaborative art work on Van Gough's 'Starry night' and Spruce class did a beautiful collaboration on 'hand themed' artwork.







<u>Literacy</u>: The children are continuing to enjoy our Literacy topic based on the book 'Origin of the Species' We have been writing non-chronological reports around Darwin and his theory of Evolution. After half term, we will be writing our own non-chronological reports about an animal that is extinct.

<u>Science</u>: We have spent the last couple of weeks learning about our electricity topic which will continue after half term. We have done some exciting investigations around static electricity and found out about series and parallel circuits. Does having two batteries have an impact on how bright the bulb will light? How can we make the buzzer sound? Why do Christmas tree lights use a parallel circuit?
