

Post 16 results 2019

Headlines

Our Post 16 students achieved fantastic results across both A Level and vocational subjects. The average point score per entry was up significantly on the previous year and ahead of national across all measures. Students were successful in securing an impressive range of destinations, including high level apprenticeships and courses at top universities, with 3 students gaining places at Oxbridge.

Year 11 results 2019

A summary of the Key Stage 4 performance is shown in the table below. Please note that these figures differ slightly from those published in performance tables as the school follows a policy of early entry in some subjects to maximise a pupil's opportunity to succeed. The results below are the actual, or real results, achieved by the Year 11 cohort in 2019.

Headlines

The number of students attaining good passes in Maths and English is a very pleasing 71%, with the same percentage of boys as girls achieving that standard. We are delighted to see our students attaining the highest achievement of grade 9 in a range of subjects (there were 22 grade 9s in total), with many outstanding results for individual students.
