Feedback on Rewards System:

- Reserved seating is the same as jump-queue pass
- Deadlines have now been set for R.P to be completed and data reports will be sent out. More clarification to staff and pupils needed on how to see how many points they have
- Need to review prize to point ratio e.g list of individual prizes and the number of points they will cost.
- See about whether Year 11 can get the prom ticket/yearbook discount back?
- Possibility if we can get the number of points on your computer like you do for printing credit in IT
- More tangible reward prizes (lack of ideas so far on this topic)
