Headlines

Our Post 16 students achieved fantastic results across A Level and vocational subjects. Attainment across A level subjects rose to an average grade of B-, with attainment across Applied General subjects of Distinction. Value added was significantly positive across both types of qualification. Students were successful in securing an impressive range of destinations, including high level apprenticeships and courses at top universities.

Headlines

Outcomes for Year 11 students were very strong across the board. Students who achieved well in English and Maths generally did so across all subjects, with 76% of students achieving the benchmark 5 standard passes including English and Maths, and 55% of students achieving 5 strong passes including English and Maths. There were many outstanding results for individual students, with an impressive total of 59 grade 9s.
