The Diocese of Westminster Academy Trust Provider Access Policy

Introduction

This policy statement sets out the Trust's arrangements for managing the access of providers to pupils at the Trust schools for the purposes of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer. This complies with the school's legal obligations under Section 42B of the Education Act 1997.

Student entitlement

Students in years 8-13 are entitled:

- To find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeships opportunities, as part of a careers programme which provides information on the full range of education and training options available at each transition point.
- To hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education and apprenticeships – through options evenings, assemblies and group discussions and taster events.
- To understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses.

Management of provider access requests

Procedure

As our Trust is split over the Diocese of Westminster the Board appreciate that different providers may wish to have access to different schools across the Trust. A provider wishing to request access should in the first instance contact the Headteachers PA at the relevant school to arrange access, each of our schools web sites can be accessed through the Trust site:
