

School Uniform

**Essential items of uniform obtainable only from Sogan's of Hammersmith.
Sogan's visit the school on the first Monday of the month at 3.20 pm**

School Blazer

School Skirt

School Sweater

White blouse with pressed, revered collar

Coat - plain navy or black. No patterns or logos (Optional)

Either Socks (white, knee High) Or Tights (black, navy or flesh coloured)

Scarf, gloves and hat - school blue or navy (Optional)

School Bag / Rucksack / Messenger Bag (approved designs only available from Sogan's)

Plain black shoes are compulsory for all. The shoes must support the feet and must be waterproof. Fabric shoes are not permitted. Stiletto or heeled shoes are not allowed.

JEWELLERY

For reasons of safety and security only one pair of small plain stud earrings in gold may be worn, one in each lobe of the lower ear. A watch may be worn. No other jewellery is allowed. Body piercing is not allowed.

HAIR

Hair slides, toggles and ribbons should be navy blue, school blue, yellow or white. Long hair should be tied back neatly and not in elaborate fashions. Hair extensions are discouraged as they are flammable. Unnatural hair colours are not acceptable.

TAKE PRIDE IN YOUR UNIFORM

1. Stilettos, platforms, thick-soled shoes or boots are not allowed.
2. Nail varnish, false nails or cosmetics are **NEVER** allowed. We will ask for these to be removed.
3. Extra layers of clothing, which may be necessary in the coldest weather, should be worn under uniform and **SHOULD NOT BE VISIBLE**, either at the neckline or through the school blouse because of strong patterning or colour.
4. Uniform should always be clean, pressed and in good repair. Girls should be encouraged to take a pride in their neat appearance. Holes should be mended, buttons sown.

Full school uniform must be worn to and from school. Behaviour should also be exemplary to and from school. Whilst wearing uniform rules and regulations apply inside and outside school.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIFORM

All items of clothing should be clearly labelled with the pupil's name. **All clothing must be free from logos.** Name branded items, even with the most discrete label or trademark, with the exception of trainers (yr. 8 and above) will be considered to be incorrect kit.

Compulsory

- PE Blouse (White polo with logo)
- PE Shorts (Navy Polyester)
- Socks (Short ankle, 3 pack)
- Plimsolls (White lace-up)
- School PE Bag (available from the school office only)

Optional

- The PE Department will decide, in exceptionally hot weather, if a plain navy or plain white baseball cap may be worn.
- PE Shirt (Navy Pleated)
- Tracksuit (Navy) or Plain Navy Jogging Suit with no logos

Note:

Gym/Dance:

Games skirts are not to be worn during gym or dance. Plain navy sport shorts, plain navy jogging bottoms, with white school polo shirt with school crest are required.

Trainers or plimsolls are also not to be worn unless specified by the teacher.

At **no** time are tights allowed to be worn during any P.E. lesson. If at any time a pupil should forget her P.E. kit she will be expected to **wear the school's kit provided** and expected to participate. A detention will be set **in addition**. If pupils have a note from home they are still expected to bring their kit and participate as directed by their teacher.

If pupils are unable to participate fully owing to a medical exemption (Doctor's Note) they are still expected to participate as directed by their teacher.
