

## Report on the use of Pupil Premium Funding 2016 - 2017

Overview	The Pupil Premium is designed to ensure that funding to tackle disadvantage reaches the pupils who need it most. The funding is allocated to LAs and schools with pupils from Reception to Year Six who are eligible for free school meals (FSM), are looked after or have parents who are currently in the Armed forces.
