The school ensures that students who make good academic progress, contribute to the wider school community and who show consistent good behaviour are recognised and, where appropriate, rewarded. There are a number of ways that this is achieved-

- Individual calls home from subject staff or from the tutor to parents giving praise.
- Letters home from tutors commenting on good work, behaviour or community service
- Achievement points which are issued by subject staff are recorded via the SIMS behaviour module.
- End of term celebration assembly rewards Progress, Achievement, Attendance and Community Service
- Annual Prize Giving Ceremony acknowledging and celebrating the achievement of students past and present
