PHSE Policy Updates

- Policy redrafted to reflect recent government changes.
- Key themes include grief and loss, respectful relationships, and encouraging individuality ("dare to be different").
- Changes discussed with attendees.
- Policy remains flexible and tailored to the needs of the school.
- All policies will be uploaded to the school website and parents will be informed of updates.

Curriculum Delivery

- Year 5 and 6 puberty education delivered by the school nurse.
- School nurse visits classes to deliver and discuss curriculum content.
- Parents will be informed of content and have the opportunity to discuss with staff.

Wellbeing Ambassadors

- Pastoral panels include anti-bullying, wellbeing, and online safety.
- Representatives from each year group (except Key Stage 1, who are "Kindness Champions").
- Role similar to school council but focused on specific responsibilities.
- Pupils will be consulted at key points during the year.
- Ambassadors will run assemblies and organise events such as Anti-Bullying Week.

Invictus Games Project

- Year 5 team attended workshops at a rugby club.
- Students created assemblies promoting positive mental health and wellbeing.
- Opportunities to collaborate with both primary and secondary schools.

Project Learning

- Curriculum projects designed to integrate multiple subject areas.

- Teacher-led initiatives with clear aims and objectives.
- Examples include World War II (Year 6) and Victorians (Year 4).
- Focus on building community links and encouraging wider staff collaboration.
- Potential collaboration with film students to create summer term projects.

- Explore opportunities for community and external partnerships.
