In order to set up the alert please follow the steps below:

- Log on to [www.scopay.com](http://www.scopay.com)
- Enter your username and password.
- Select alerts on the top bar.
- Click on the link to subscribe to the Alerts service.
- Select emails and click confirm.
- Click on 'click here to configure your alerts'.
- Place a tick in the box to receive alerts when your child's balance drops below a certain balance.
- Enter the amount in the box so that you are sent an alert when the balance drops below this amount.
- Click on update at the bottom of the page.

Alerts will be delivered to your registered email address and can be viewed from your normal mailbox.
