## What does Child Protection mean?

At Peters Hill, all of the adults around you think that your health, safety and welfare are very important. In our school we respect our children and want to keep you safe and help protect your rights.

We teach you how to recognise risks in different situations and how to protect yourself and stay safe.

This is called Safeguarding.



## How will we try to protect you?

We try to provide a safe environment for you to learn in. We want you to be safe in school and at home.

We think it is very important for you to know where to get help if you are worried or unhappy about something.



## If you need to talk, we will listen!

You can talk to any adult in school that you feel comfortable with.

Mr Duncan, Mrs Curnin, Mrs Owen, Mrs Foxall and Mrs Bridgwater have a special duty to keep you safe like all the adults in school and you can talk to us at any time.

You can tell a friend and they can tell an adult if you feel worried to tell an adult

You can leave a note on a teachers desk, letting them know you need to talk



## Don't keep it a secret if someone is;

Bullying you. Remember the **STOP** phrase to help you decide if you are being bullied. When something is happening **Several Times On Purpose**.

Saying things to you that do not like or upsets you.

Touching you or trying to look up your skirt.

Trying to give you things that are only for adults, like medicines, cigarettes or alcohol.

Hitting you or hurting you

Taking your things

Sending unkind messages on the internet or to your phone

Asking you to send them personal information like your address, school name, phone number

Asking you to send pictures of yourself

Telling you to keep their messages a secret
