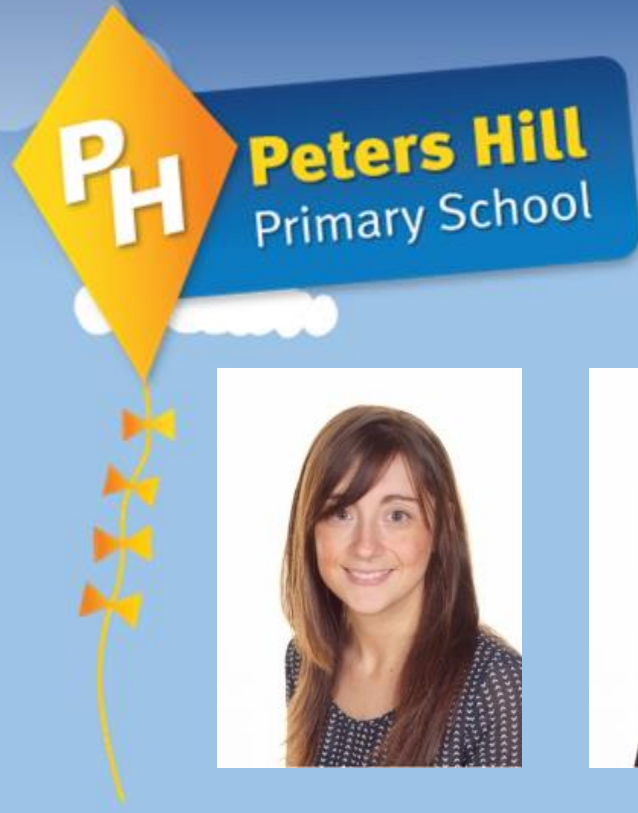

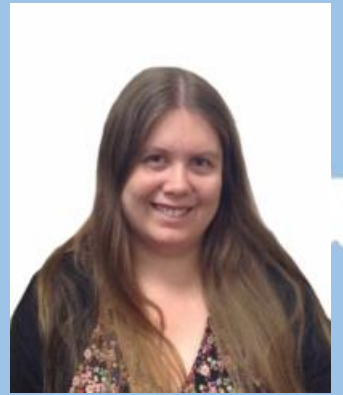

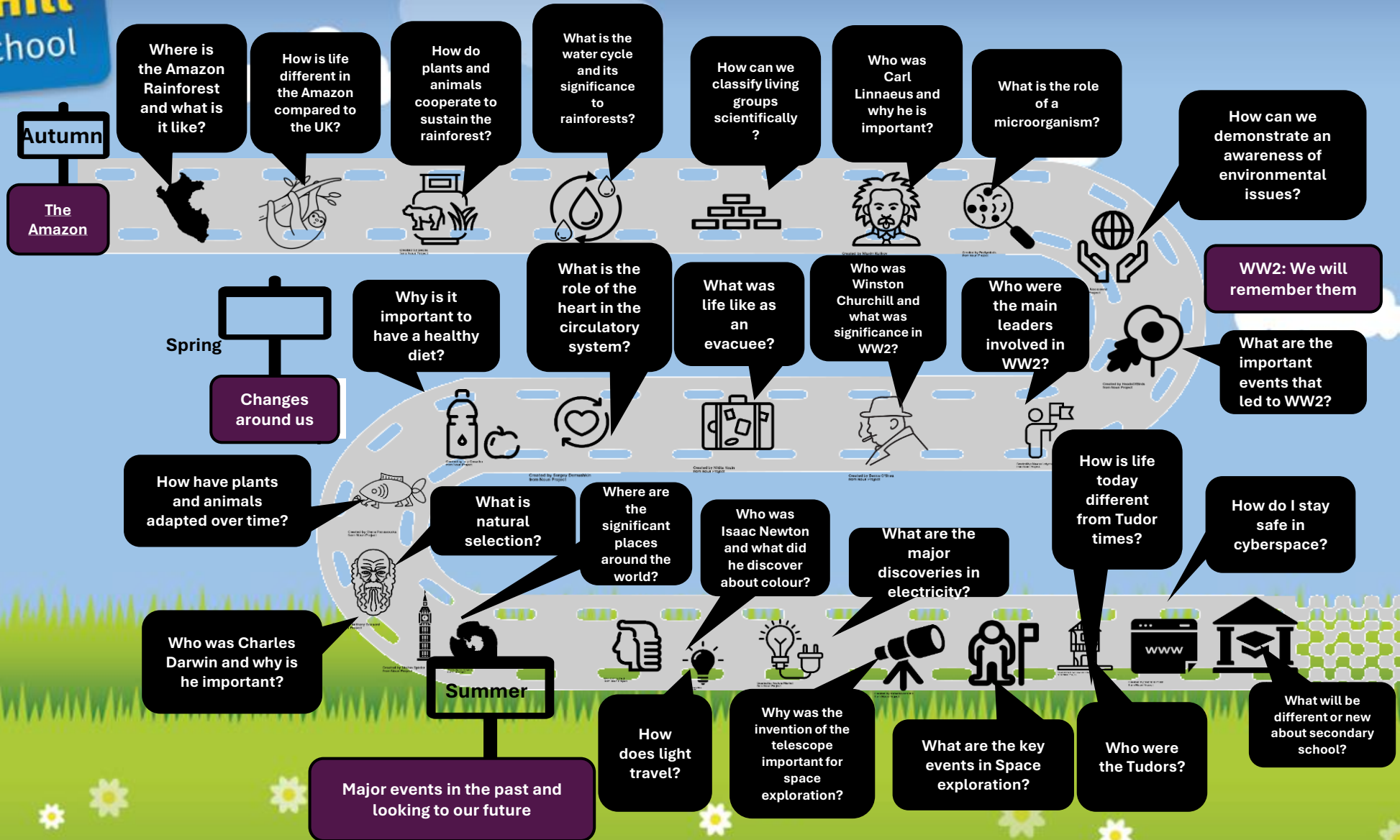
In Year 6 you may have different teachers for different lessons, this will prepare you for Year 7, but you will be with your class teacher for most of the time.

- Other trips will be confirmed as the year goes on.

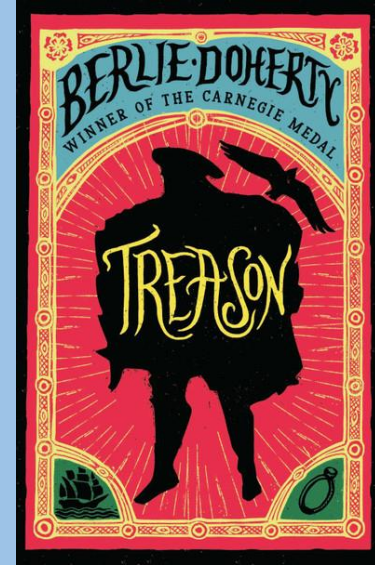
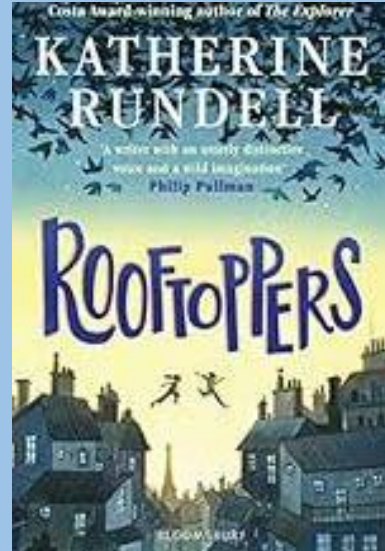

Reading Champions

Reading Champions love to read and collect rewards for being book worms!

Here's how to collect your rewards:

1. Read your book at least 3 times a week. Ask your grown ups to sign your reading record to show that you have read at home. Each week, you get a sticker.
2. When you have received 10 stickers, you collect your first reward: a beautiful bookmark!
3. 20 stickers and you'll earn an eraser!
4. 30 stickers and you'll possess a pencil!
5. 40 stickers and you're blown away by your very own book!

So get started! Enjoy your books and collect some great rewards as you read!



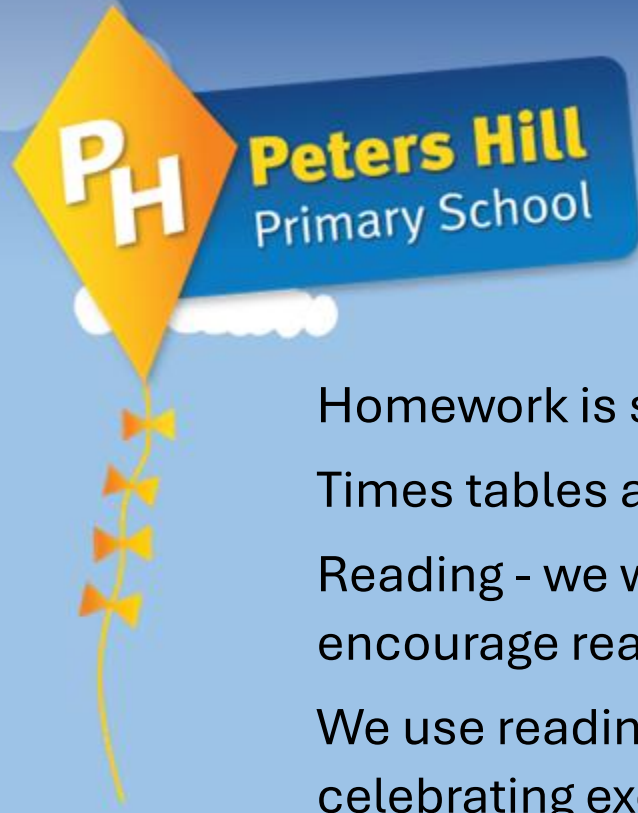
Homework diary

MyMaths online learning & Timetables Rockstar continues

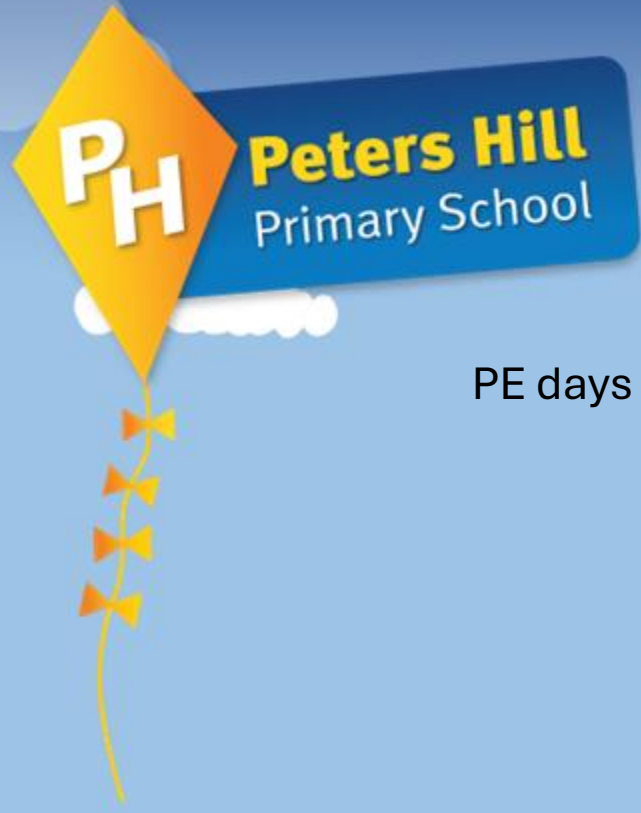
Spellings - rule taught Monday and tested Friday



Mobile Phones

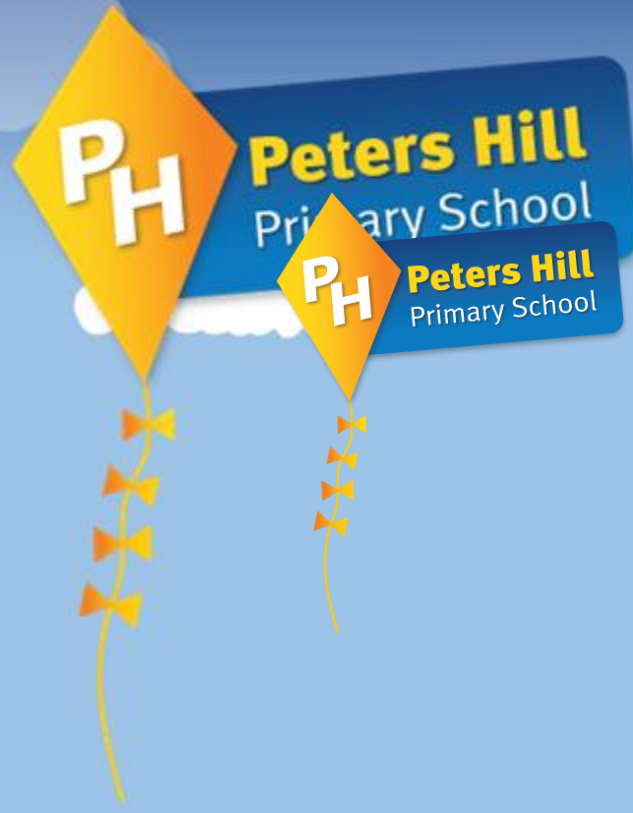
