

Linking to our Geography topic, as a musician I will learn:

- How to sing songs from memory with accurate pitch.
- How to compose a piece of music inspired by volcanoes and earthquakes.

As a geographer I will learn:

- About the city of Naples and the Campania region and its surrounding oceans
- About the structure of volcanoes and why they erupt
- About earthquakes and volcanoes around the world through case studies as part of our charity link

Linking to our Geography topic, as a designer I will learn:

- How to sketch a self-portrait in the style of Julian Opie pretending I have witnessed the eruption of Mount Vesuvius
- To use lines, shape and colour to represent figures and forms in movements

In my personal development I will learn:

- About the changes we go through in life and how to embrace different changes
- How to respect the views and opinions of others, and share my wishes sensibly with my peers

Linking to our Geography, as a historian I will learn:

- About the eruption of Mount Vesuvius and the historical city of Naples
- To make comparisons between life in the Roman city of Naples with our lives today

Linking to our Geography topic, as a sport person I will learn:

- To explore different shapes, levels and pathways in dance
- To use a motif within a dance.
- To develop knowledge of rules and scoring.
- To know all the rules of a rounders game.

Linking to our maths topic, as an IT expert I will learn:

- How to create my own database to answer questions
- To gather my own data and choose how to present it carefully in a chart using a program

In RE I will learn:

- About the Christian place of worship and why Christians attend Church
- About what happens during a Christian worship and debate whether it is important for all Christians to attend Church

As a scientist I will learn:

- How to identify and describe the different types of teeth in humans.
- How to describe the functions of different human teeth.
- How to construct food chains to identify producers, predators and prey.

Linking to our Geography topic, as a writer I will learn:

- To write in role as a character from a story to produce a diary entry
- To use varied and adventurous vocabulary in my writing
- To write and perform my own descriptive poetry about volcanoes.

Our theme and topic will be:

### **Destroying an Empire: the Eruption of Mount Vesuvius.**

Our class text is *The Firework Maker's Daughter*. As a reader I will learn:

- To compare the work of different writers
- To understand how writers use language for effect on the reader
- To understand the effect of similes and metaphors in descriptive poetry
