As a scientist I will learn:

As a reader I will learn:

- To distinguish between statements of fact and opinion.
- To use P.E.E effectively when answering complex questions about my reading.
- To retrieve, record and present information from my non-fiction reading and research.

As a mathematician I will learn:

- Calculating percentages of amounts.
- Recall and use equivalences between simple fractions, decimals and percentages.
- Find pairs of numbers that satisfy an equation with two unknowns.
- Draw 2-D shapes, using given dimensions and angles.
- Recognise that shapes with the same areas can have different perimeters.
- Compare and classify geometric shapes based on their properties and sizes and find unknown angles.
