

CORE BRITISH VALUES

Round Oak School actively promotes fundamental 'British' values. This includes the values of democracy, the rule of the law, individual liberty and mutual respect/ tolerance for others.

At Round Oak School each of these values are reinforced regularly in the following ways:

- **Democracy-** Students have a say in school life as part of the student council. The whole school votes regularly on a variety of issues.
- **Liberty-** Students are actively encouraged to make choices, knowing that they are in a safe environment and also understanding that they are accountable for those choices. Fab Fridays are an integral part of this.
- **Respect and Tolerance-** Mutual respect is an integral part of the culture at Round Oak School. Our curriculum teaches students to respect the values and beliefs of others, which extends to the whole school philosophy.
- **Law-** Pupils understand the difference between right and wrong. They recognise that there are consequences for every choice that they make and apply this to their lives inside and outside of school by respecting English civil and criminal law.
- **Responsibility-** We expect our students to be proactive in their learning, understanding that they are equally responsible for their learning as the teacher.
