Tasks to complete at home

1. Share **stories** daily with your child at home.
2. Watch and practise **Set 1 sounds, blending and Fred fingers** using RWI video clips to support.
3. We will look at the fairy tale - **Jack and the Beanstalk** this week. The Oak Academy website is an excellent resource to support your child with this at home and you can watch the lessons online. Activities are linked to each lesson which you can complete at home. For example - listening to the story, story mapping, role play and writing simple sentences. You will find the link in the additional resources list below. Please focus on lesson 1-5 for this week. You might like to get creative this week by role playing the fairy tale at home. You could create your own masks to role play the characters (Jack, the Giant, the cow, Jack's mother, the golden goose...) You could also create your very own castle for the giant using recyclable items such as cereal boxes and yogurt pots. You may even like to plant a bean seed and watch it grow. This is all part of our 'Knowledge of the World' and 'Expressive Arts and Design' work which we would learn about at school.
4. Watch and listen to the **RE lessons** about 'Celebrations' this week. After you have watched the lessons complete the worksheets. On the first worksheet you can draw and label picture of a special celebration. On the second worksheet encourage your child to talk about what is happening in the picture of Anna and Simeon at the temple and your child can then colour the picture in. Write down what your child says in the text box. On the third worksheet your child will need to draw a picture of Simeon and Anna at the temple. Encourage your child to use their phonic knowledge to write words to label their picture such as Anna, Simeon, temple, Jesus, Mary and Joseph. They might even like to write a short sentence. The worksheets will be available on Class Dojo.
5. Please remember to share the **virtual prayer bag** with your child. You will find the video in the 'RE' folder on Microsoft Teams. Your child can upload their prayers to Class Dojo and you might like to set out a prayer table at home.
6. A **music** session has also been uploaded to Microsoft Teams for your child to join in with.
7. Your child will need their 10 frame, some counting objects and their Maths Journal for the Power Maths lessons next week. You can print or draw the 10 frame - or you may like to use an egg box with 10 spaces.

Please upload completed work onto your child's portfolio via Class Dojo - we would love to see your work from home. Thank you for your continued support.

	<p>Subject(s) & Tasks</p>
<p>Monday</p>	<p>9.30am Welcome session, prayer and Dough Disco (live lesson)</p> <p>Children will practice fine motor skills to develop strength for pencil control, pencil grip and handwriting.</p> <p>Handwriting session (Pre-recorded to watch later)</p> <p>Children will practice letter formation for the following letters. Children will be encouraged to use the correct pencil grip and will say the phrase for each letter as they write. Children can complete their handwriting in their green exercise book.</p> <p>Power Maths session (Pre-recorded to watch later)</p> <p>This week children will compare numbers up to 10. They will focus on comparing groups of objects where the objects differ in size. We will be using 10 frames this week. You can use an egg box with 10 spaces, draw your own 10 frame or print out the 10 frame from Class Dojo. Also, have your child's Power Maths Reflective Journal to hand as we will use this for our number work in some of the lessons.</p> <p>RWI session online (please check your child's individual portfolio on ClassDojo to access learning materials)</p> <p>Children will practise speed sounds and blending to read through RWI online lessons. Children will receive individual lessons suited to their needs. When prompted to do so in their RWI lessons children can complete their writing in the red 'word time' book which is in their home/school pack.</p> <p>RE Session (pre-recorded to watch later) Worksheets for the lesson will be available on Class Dojo. If you unable to print these out the work can be completed on any paper that you have at home.</p> <p>2pm Story time (live lesson) and prayer session</p>
