Summer Term

Communication & Language and Literacy Read, Write Inc programme-

- Sounds of the alphabet & letter formation

Religious Education (Holy Time)

Pentecost - Serving - Topic- Good News; Children learn that 'Alleluia' is a word to praise God, Jesus sends a friend called the Holy Spirit, Pentecost is the coming of the Holy Spirit and sharing the Good News that Jesus is alive.

Reconciliation- Inter-relating- Topic- Friends; Children learn about Jesus' relationship with his disciples, talking to Jesus as a friend, God is always willing to forgive, saying sorry and forgiving others, praying the 'Our Father'.

Universal Church -World- Topic- Our World; Children learn that God created the world, everyone shares God's world, taking care of the world & belonging to God's family

Understanding the World

Holidays- Making Pirate role-play area, burying treasure, digging for treasure using magnets, drawing & labelling pirate maps, following instructions of how to make a boat, floating & sinking in water, reading stories ...
