<b>Thursday</b> <b>7.01.21</b>	<p><b>Power Maths session</b></p> <p>Children will focus on numbers 1-10. This will include counting in order, recognising numbers and ordering numbers. Watching and practising Set 1 sounds, blending and Fred fingers using RWI video clips to support.</li> <li>3. Writing a thank you letter to Santa to thank him for our Christmas gifts</li> <li>4. Designing a Happy New Year card.</li> <li>5. Thinking about the 'big question' for RE and recording children's responses on Class Dojo. (Preparation for our topic 'Celebrations' which we will teach from next week).</li> </ol>
