I have always been interested in space and this week decided to do a virtual tour of our solar system. I learnt lots of interesting facts and it even helped me to win a family quiz because I found out that Saturn's largest of its 150 moons is called Titan.

Did you know it takes Saturn 29 years to orbit the sun? It only takes Earth 1 year!

I was also fascinated to find out that our solar system has a number of dwarf planets. I only knew about Pluto but there are 4 other dwarf planets called Ceres, Eris, Makemake and Haumea. Haumea is shaped like a pebble and is the least spherical of the dwarf planets.
