Welcome to this month's Newsletter. I trust you and your family enjoyed the Easter break

**EASTER** - In the first half of this term the children have been learning about the journey from Easter to Pentecost. The focus of our term's work in RE is the role the Holy Spirit plays in our lives, exploring Pentecost, Reconciliation and the Universal Church. **YEAR OF PRAYER AND VOCATION** - In December Bishop Peter launched the Year of Prayer and Vocation 2017/ 2018. It is also important for the children to go to bed early to ensure they perform to their best during the tests. We wish all our children well and will keep them in our thoughts and prayers at this important time.

We decided to raise money for NICU to celebrate the first birthday of Evie Rose Shambrook, the daughter of one of our teachers Mrs Shambrook/ Miss Hopwood, who was born prematurely and weighed less than one pound at birth. Due to the care she received Evie is doing very well and enjoyed her first birthday party. A total of **£407** was raised, a very special thanks to Alice Birmingham in Year 2 who donated her birthday money to this very worthy cause.
