If your children are not members you can join on line and they will issue a registration reference number and ask you to set a pin. **Make sure you keep a record of this registration reference number as you will need it to log in.**

Click on links at side such as ebooks or Children's Room and it will take you e resources. You will have to set up a log in for some areas such as rbproduct if they ask for the library membership number use the registration number you were given when you registered for a library account.
