Monday	<p>Maths: Watch video on Class Story – Mind Workout Textbook – complete page 187 Education City – addition – complete x2 activities.</p> <p>English/Science: Go to the BBC website and watch the videos on these habitats – rainforest, ocean, polar, desert. https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/subjects/z6svr82. Complete each quiz Make a list of 5 facts for each habitat.</p> <p>Spelling: Unit 13 – adding the suffix –ment. Complete Spelling Zone p.44 (ignore Speed Spell)</p> <p>Read EVERY day</p>
Tuesday	<p>Maths: Watch video on Class story – Mind Workout Workbook - complete page 248 Education City – addition – complete x2 activities.</p> <p>English/Science: Read the information sheets about ‘Working Together, Staying Alive’ with your child and discuss. Choose one habitat, draw it and write some sentences to explain dependency within that habitat.</p> <p>Spelling: Unit 13 - complete Dots and dashes and Word changers p. 45</p> <p>Read EVERY day</p>
Wednesday	<p>Maths: Watch video on Class story – Review 8 - complete pages 249 & 250 Education City – addition – complete x2 activities.</p> <p>English/Science: Go to the BBC bite size website as before. Watch the video ‘What is a food chain? Complete the quiz. Draw and label 2 different food chains and write some sentences to explain what is happening.</p> <p>Spelling: Unit 13 - complete Dictation activity p.46 Adult to read first sentence repeatedly while your child writes the sentence. Then show your child the sentence and tick or fix sentence. Repeat for sentence two. 1 – I will think about the punishment. 2 – I stood back in amazement.</p> <p>Read EVERY day</p>
Thursday	<p>Maths: Watch video on Class story – Revision 2 - complete pages 251 - 254 Education City – addition – complete x2 activities.</p> <p>English/Science: Today we are going to look at a contrasting habitat to our local urban habitat – so get your buckets and spades ready because we are off to the seaside! Ask your child to read the reading comprehension sheet ‘Beach Habitat Reading Comprehension’ and then answer the questions. Choose one comprehension sheet to read and answer – there are 3 to choose from of different levels. This comprehension focusses on animal life.</p> <p>Spelling: Complete Four-in-a-row game p.46 (instructions are on the page).</p> <p>Read EVERY day</p>
Friday	<p>Maths: Today we would like you to create your own pictogram about birthdays in your class. We will attach a class list with everyone’s birthday on it in class story the day before. You will first need to make a table to show all of the information and then you will need to make a picture graph. You can be as creative as you like! Bonus monster points for if you have worked really hard.</p>

	<p>Education City – addition – complete x2 activities.</p> <p>English/Science: Ask your child to read the reading comprehension sheet ‘All About Beaches’ and then answer the questions. Choose one comprehension sheet to read and answer – there are 3 to choose from of different levels. This comprehension focusses on beaches around the UK.</p> <p>Spelling: Complete Speed p. 44 using words of your choice from Spelling Zone. Cover up the words bellows so that your child cannot see them. Tick or fix words.</p> <p>Read EVERY day</p>
