Weekly Project; Due 10th February

This week we are going to continue our theme of science projects!

Last week you experimented with skittles, to remove their colour using boiling water to make a rainbow! Hope you all enjoyed that. We had lots of fabulous work submitted on ClassDojo!

This week we are going to ask you to experiment with *Coca-Cola* and *Mentos*!

Step 1. We would like you to make a *prediction* about what you think *will happen* before you start the experiment.

Step 2. Please write this down somewhere safe, because you are going to test if you're correct!

Step 3. Grab a bottle of *Coca-Cola* and a tube of *Mentos*!

Step 4. *Go outside* as this is going to get messy!

Step 5. Take the cap off the bottle of *Coca-Cola* and drop a couple of *Mentos* in!

Bonus: If you want to see the bottle explode, you can put the cap back on. This will make *gas* build up in the bottle, until it cannot hold any more!

Step 6. Step back and watch the show!

Step 7. Write down the *result*, what actually happened, and *compare* this to your *prediction* to see if you were correct!

Step 8. Upload work to Dojo!

Mental Health Awareness Week Activities

- Build something - Use building blocks, recycled materials, chairs, a deck of cards or anything else you can find to build a den, a tower, a vehicle or a robot.
- Create a family Quiz - Who knows who best?
- Play a board game - you could even design and make your own.

- Scavenger Hunt - Can you find a object for each letter of the alphabet?
- Read, Read, Read! Share a book with someone in your home.
- Be a Nature Spotter - how many birds, insects and bugs can you find. Record your results in a tally chart.
- Sketch a portrait - Ask a family member to sit still while you draw them. Can you do all of your family members?
- Look through family photos - spend time as a family sharing memories.
- Ask a family member to share a skill with you.
- Cooking - Can you make a tasty treat for your family. Under adult supervision.
- Draw a map - Recreate your rooms in your house as a pirate treasure map. Or share your journey to school.
- Get creative with words - write a rap, poem or song about something you enjoy.
- Write a postcard to a family member that you haven't seen in a while. Tell them all about your home learning.
- Make a nature collage with items from your garden -_using sticks, leaves, twigs.
- Investigate Volume -_Use a variety of different containers, which holds more/less?
