Weekly Project; Due 10th February

This week we are going to continue our theme of science projects!

This week we are going to ask you to experiment with Celery and food colouring!

You will need:

- Celery sticks with leafy tops
- A clear glass
- Water
- Food colouring

Experiment:

Pour your water into your glass. Add in 8 drops of food colouring and stir with your celery stick. Mix until the food colouring is evenly spread in the water. Leave the celery stick in the water and watch what happens. What happened to the celery?

Questions to think about during your experiment:

What colour are the leaves of your celery?

Can you put your celery into the glass of coloured water?

Can you find a sunny spot to put your experiment?

What colour are the leaves of your celery now?

What has made them change colour?

Which parts of the plant use lots of water?
