### **English & PSHE tasks this week** (on the weekly timetable):

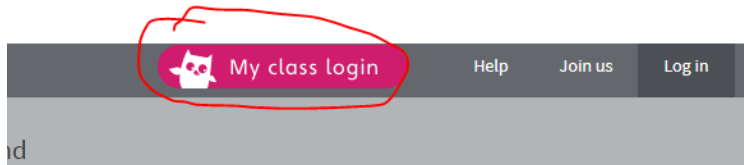

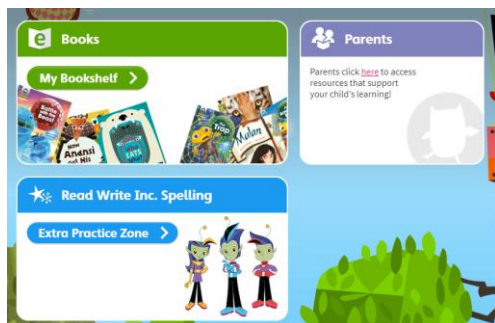
