Statutory Consultation on the proposed amendment the admissions arrangements

All admission authorities are obliged to consult on changes to their admissions arrangements. As the Admissions Authority for all schools within Mercian Educational Trust, the directors are consulting on changes to criteria within the admissions arrangements, starting in September 2020.

The Directors, welcome your views on the proposed changes to the admission arrangements.

Rationale

The reasons for the proposed changes to our admissions arrangements and increase in PAN at this point are:

- To standardise admissions criteria within all MET schools, ensuring equality of admission throughout the Trust
- To provide greater clarity for each admission criteria
- To produce a robust admission policy to accommodate rising demand for school places in MET Schools
