Reading	Read every night for 20 minutes. Children to record what they have read in their Reading Record and this should be initiated by an adult. A mixture of reading independently and aloud is encouraged, as well as different genres and authors. Children should make sure they have their Reading Record and book every day in school. These will be checked by the class teacher every Monday .
Spellings	Spelling test will be every Friday . New spellings will be given out on Fridays in the Home Spelling Book to be learnt for the following week. Children can practise these each day using the book and they must bring this with them every Friday.
Maths	Children will receive times tables on a Monday to be tested the following Monday. They should bring in their Home Times Tables book every Monday. Children should practise these daily. Children can use their Times Tables Rockstars logins to practise these further.
Projects	Whole school projects will be set every half term with children being given three weeks to complete these. Parents will be invited in to share these in class.
