Reading	Read every night for 20 minutes. Children to record what they have read in their <b>Pupil Planner</b> and this should be initialed by an adult. A mixture of reading independently and aloud is encouraged, as well as different genres and authors. Children should make sure they have their Pupil Planner and book every day in school. These will be checked by the class teacher every <b>Monday</b> .
Spellings	Spelling test will be every <b>Friday</b> . New spellings will be given out on Fridays in the <b>Home Spelling Book</b> to be learnt for the following week. Children can practise these each day using the book and they must bring this with them every Friday.
Maths	Children will receive Maths Facts on a <b>Monday</b> to be tested the following Monday. They should bring in their <b>Home Maths Facts book</b> every Monday. Children should practise these daily. Times Tables will form part of these and children can use their Times Tables Rockstars logins to practise these further.
Projects	Whole school projects will be set every half term with children being given three weeks to complete these. Parents will be invited in to share these in class.
