School Uniform Policy.

At St. Clare's, children are expected to wear the full school uniform at all times. We understand the benefits to the children of not being distracted by the dictates of fashion and believe that wearing their uniform gives them a sense of belonging to their school. We ask parents to support us by ensuring that their children are provided with a complete uniform, including a full P.E. kit, at all times. We also ask that ALL items of school uniform are labelled with the child's name and we do not accept responsibility for the loss of items of clothing which are not clearly marked.

BOYS - RECEPTION TO YEAR 5

Red sweatshirt with logo

Grey trousers

White polo shirt,

Black school shoes.

BOYS - YEAR 6

Black V neck sweatshirt with logo

Black trousers

White shirt with collar

Red tie

Black school shoes.

During the summer months, boys may wear short grey trousers with grey socks and school shoes or appropriate sandals.

GIRLS - RECEPTION TO YEAR 5

Red sweatshirt/cardigan with logo

Grey skirt/pinafore/smart tailored trousers (no leggings or jogging bottoms)

White polo shirt

Flat, black school shoes. These must have a strap, a t-bar or laces to reduce trip hazards.

Grey or black tights

GIRLS – YEAR 6

Black V neck sweatshirt with logo

Black skirt/smart tailored trousers (no leggings or jogging bottoms)

White shirt with collar

Red tie

Flat, black school shoes. These must have a strap, a t-bar or laces to reduce trip hazards.

Black tights

During the summer months, girls may wear red check/gingham summer dresses or their winter uniforms with white socks

They may wear their black shoes or suitable flat sandals. They must not wear flimsy, strappy shoes as these carry safety risks when running in the playground.

PE Kit

Plain white t-shirt, blue or black shorts

Indoor – black pumps

Outdoor – black pumps or trainers

Optional – sweatshirt/joggers (blue or black) for outdoor winter P.E.

P.E. kit must be kept in a drawstring P.E. bag which must have the child's name on.

ALL items of P.E. kit, including pumps, must have the child's name on.

JEWELLERY

For health and safety reasons jewellery must not be worn, apart from ear studs and watches. Children will be asked to remove all other forms of jewellery.

TRAINERS

Trainers are not accepted as part of the school uniform. They can only be worn during outdoor P.E. lessons. Children who come to school in trainers will be asked to change into their P.E. pumps whilst they are in school.
