Morrisby Online Profiling

One of the toughest challenges that students face is to know what pathways they would find fulfilling and what potential they have. As part of their preparation for progression Post-16 or Post-18, we are offering the Morrisby Online Profiling facility for students to utilise.

Morrisby Online is a guidance tool that helps students to identify potential progression paths and make informed decisions about their study options. Participating students will take an online assessment and questionnaire which measure a variety of elements including career interests, work attitudes, talents and motivations. Once the assessment is complete, students will have access to personally tailored career and education suggestions, plus a wealth of careers-related resources. The cost of the subscription to the service is **£25 per student**, which we are asking parents to fund.

As part of the subscription, each student will receive:

- A personalised, 25+ page candidate report which is available to view and download on line
- Lifetime access to the Morrisby careers and education resource website including email access to a qualified, independent Careers Adviser
- Access to a personal area on the website containing all their results, analyses and reports coupled with career and route planning tools and information

This widely used Morrisby Profile is recognized as the UK's leading psychometric test and is extremely valued by those students who take it. We are offering the Morrisby test to all Year 11, Year 12 and Year 13 students at St George's.

Feedback Interviews

We are also offering the opportunity for students to book a 15 minute feedback interview with an independent, Morrisby trained adviser, at **an additional cost of £16** (non-refundable when a student forgets to attend). The aim of these interviews is to allow each student to discuss their results with this specialist. These interviews will be booked by the students who will sign up and select appropriate times to minimise impact on their studies in January. The interviews will be held in the Careers Room in the LRC. It will be the students' responsibility to remember to attend their interview appointment.



The Morrisby assessments have been designed for the general population and most candidates have no difficulty in completing the assessments. However it is important that any learning difficulties or disabilities are noted during the registration process. Where there are some doubts on the part of students, school staff or parents about the appropriateness of the assessments for any individual candidate, we would ask you to contact me to discuss this.

How to sign up for the test and/or interview

Parents can pay on parentpay for either just the assessment, or the assessment and interview. There will therefore be two options: £25 or £41, please select which option you would like. Students who have requested an interview will then be directed to sign up for an appointment via the library staff.

We hope that your son/daughter finds the Morrisby profiling a valuable tool and process.
