# ST JOSEPH'S CATHOLIC NURSERY

## MAKING AN APPLICATION

Applicants must complete, and return to **ST JOSEPH'S SCHOOL OFFICE**, the Nursery Application Form (obtainable from the School Office, Children's Centre and online at [www.stjosephs.harrow.sch.uk](http://www.stjosephs.harrow.sch.uk)). You should also provide the stipulated documentation, including the child's proof of date of birth, original baptismal certificate and proof of address.

The closing date for return of forms to School Office is: **Friday, 8<sup>th</sup> February 2019**. Offer letters will be sent out as soon as possible after this closing date.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Admission to St Joseph's Catholic Nursery **DOES NOT** guarantee a place at St Joseph's Catholic Primary School. A completely separate application process exists for school admissions.

In **addition** to this application, the admission of a pupil with an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHC) is dealt with by a completely separate procedure. Details of this **additional** procedure are set out in the *Special Educational Needs Code of Practice*.

Applicants must provide proof of their residential address. The **ONLY** Acceptable forms of documentation are: current Council Tax bill, a copy of tenancy agreement arranged through a letting agent/estate agent or a recent letter from the housing department/housing association. **ORIGINAL DOCUMENTATION ONLY WILL BE ACCEPTED. Independent verification may be sought of the applicant's residential address.**

Unsuccessful applicants may ask to be placed on a Waiting List for the nursery. If a place becomes available, this will be allocated in accordance with the Nursery's Criteria for Admission.

If any places become available in Nursery during the year (September – July), the Governors will consider applications for children to start the term **after** they reach 3 years of age.
