Hajj Fraud Campaign

We have received the following from Mark Godsland, Force Safer Cyber Adviser at Gloucestershire Police, and would be grateful if you could pass it on to any members of the Muslim community that you feel would benefit from the advice.

"The City of London Police, in partnership with the British Council of Hajjis, is running a national Hajj fraud campaign and would greatly appreciate your assistance.

Every year Muslims booking pilgrimages to Mecca are being conned into paying for packages which are in fact fraudulent.

Through police force and partner agency communication teams we will be spreading key crime prevention messages via social, digital and local media. However, what would really make the campaign a success is if we can physically get our crime prevention leaflets into the hands of Muslim communities across the UK. Attached to this email is the Hajj fraud leaflet (print version) which provides further information about the campaign and what Muslims need to do to protect themselves when booking their trips.
