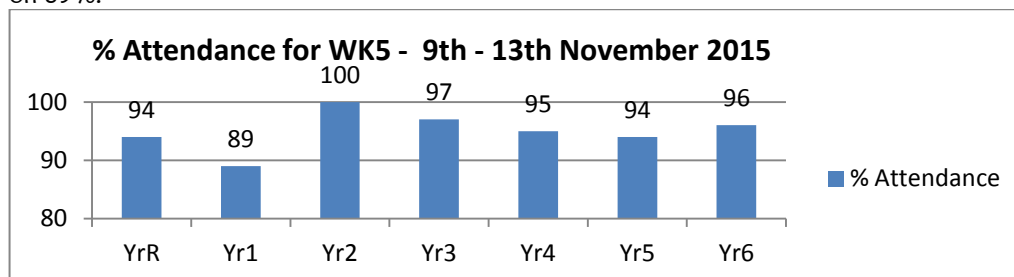




NEWSLETTER – Monday 16th November 2015
