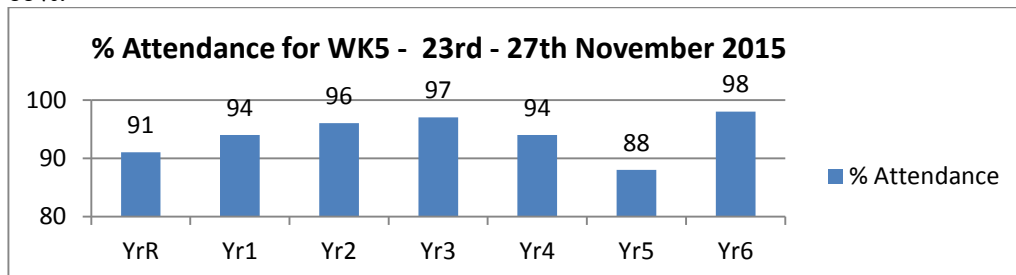




NEWSLETTER – Monday 30th November 2015
