School Nurse Drop In Sessions

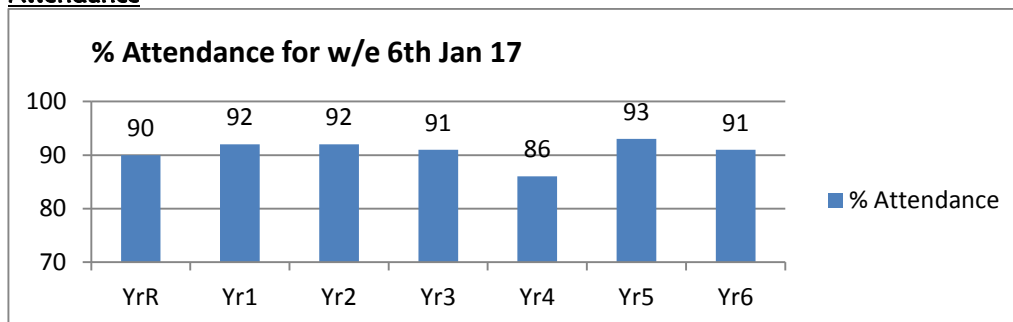
One of the school nursing team from the Borough will be holding Drop In sessions at school on the following dates:
