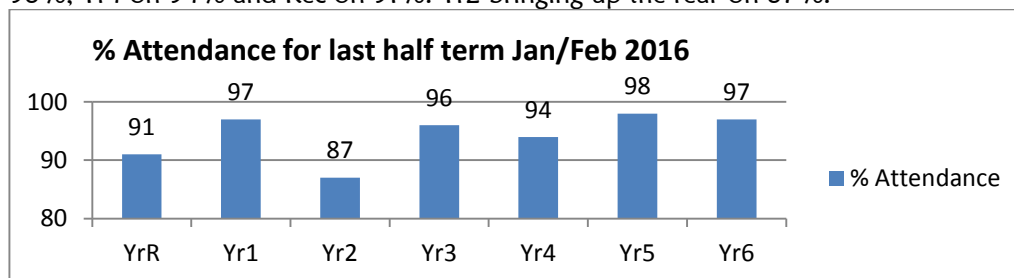




NEWSLETTER – Monday 22nd February 2016

As part of future newsletters we will be including quotations from children. We have started with the School Council and this is what they had to say.

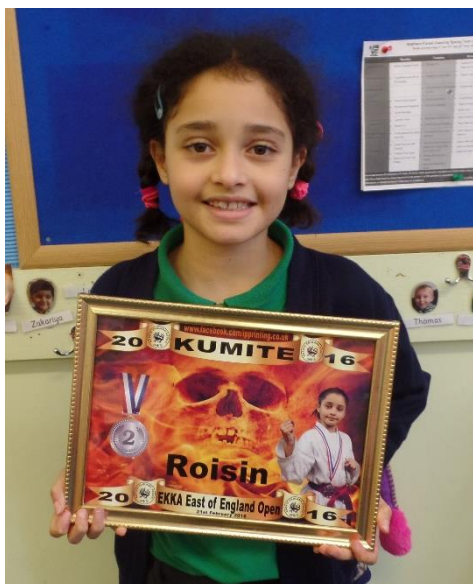
Phoenix	Y6	“I really enjoyed creating our play script.”
